Main page

The text should have line numbers from the beginning of the main page till the end, references section.

Introduction "Arial narrow, size 11.5, bold"

- Text in the introduction
- Use Arial narrow size 10.5, not bold
- State objective or aim of the study as the last paragraph of this section
- Format of the reference number in the article, use ⁽¹⁾ for the first text reference, ⁽²⁻³⁾ for the following two references, and ^(1-3,5) for many reference numbers.
- Type the reference number at the end of a phrase or sentence. ^(1, 3-4)

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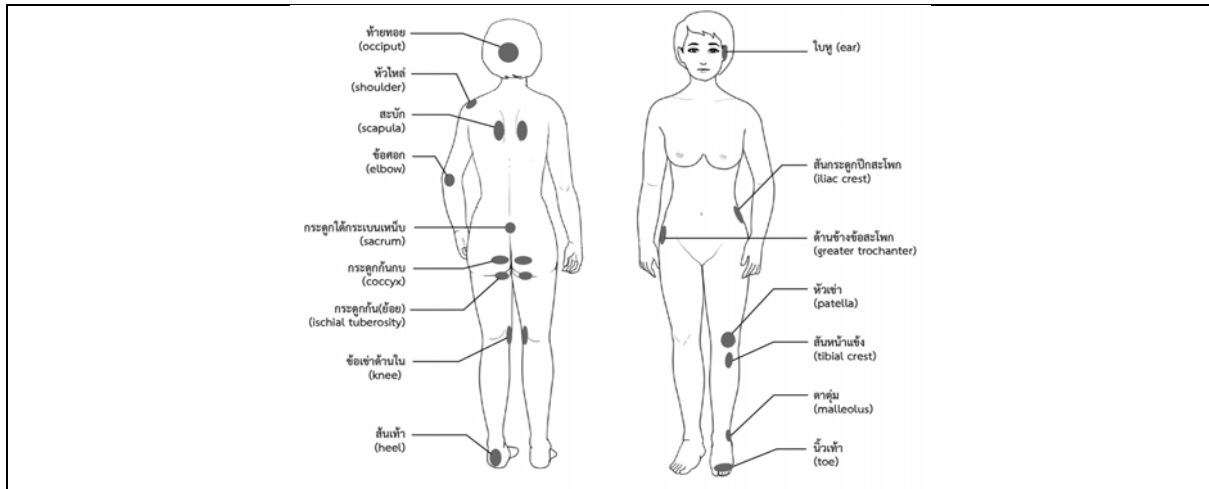


Figure 1. Common sites of pressure ulcers (use Arial narrow size 10.5, not bold)
